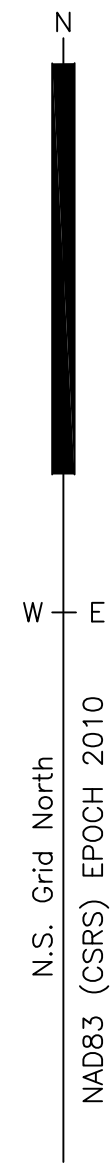

The plot size that will provide true scale and optimum readability for this plan is 1130MM by 742MM.

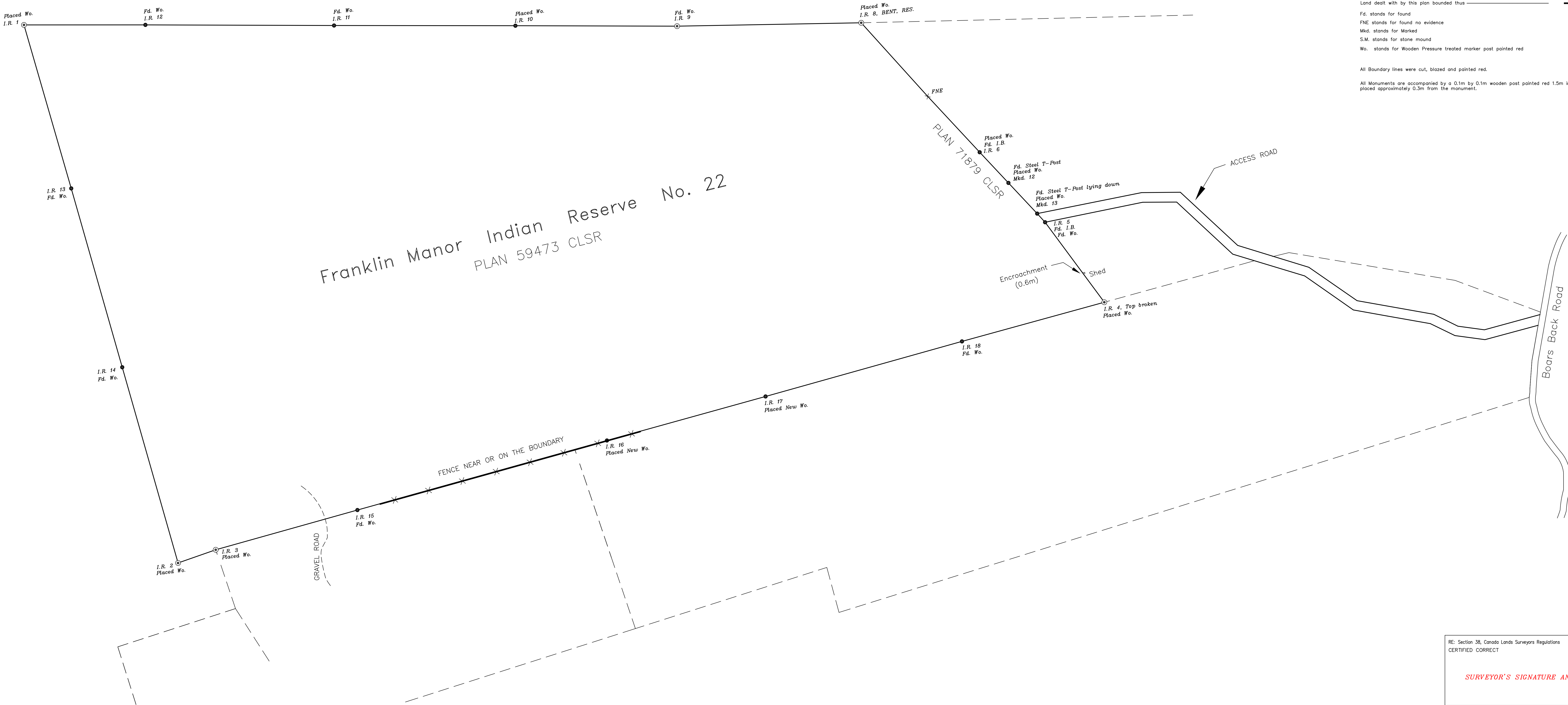
